Cell phones for seniors

Since cell phones exploded in popularity only in the last decade, quite a few people have lived well into their adult lives without ever owning one. Learning to use a new technology can be challenging for anyone, which is why some companies have stepped up to design handsets specifically for senior citizens. Senior-friendly models typically promote ease-of-use over a bushel of multimedia features that require a learning curve. Large fonts and dialpad buttons hold court, along with bright displays. We're also seeing an increasing number of medical features, like a 911 shortcut key, in-case-of-emergency (ICE) numbers, and an area to add medical notes.

PCD CDM8635 (U.S. Cellular) looks like your typical flip phone but adds useful shortcut keys, usability wizards, and hearing assistance tools as a nod toward seniors. Meanwhile, the rather boxy **Samsung Haven (Verizon)** also has handy shortcuts and voice command, but differentiates with reminder alarms, medical info, and "healing music." Um, we'll take a pass on that last one. It may look like a calculator with its tiny face and huge numbered buttons, but the unlocked **Just5 J509** sands out for its slim profile and excellent call quality. The SOS emergency button, text messaging service, flashlight, and FM radio are notable extras.

Also making our roundup are the **Doro PhoneEasy 410 (Consumer Cellular)** and the **Pantech Breeze II (AT&T)**, an entry-level flip phone with a music player and Bluetooth, which is also accessible for new users.
